



Lucasfilm is proud to announce the Lucasfilm Student Art Competition!

In our quest to find the best and brightest up-and-coming artists throughout the galaxy, Lucasfilm and Lucasfilm Animation would like to invite Parsons students to participate in our competition this year. Contestants have the chance to win once-in-a-lifetime trips to visit Lucasfilm artists at the famous Big Rock Ranch in Marin and/or \$1,000 cash!

Entrants will be asked to submit original, two-dimensional artistic interpretations inspired by the following:

Theme: Adventure / Man vs. Nature

Place: Deep in an unexplored jungle / cave

The Explorers discover something frozen in ice / amber. The dim lights reveal shapes of not one, but multiple beings. The explorers' excitement is interrupted by a screech of some animal hidden the foliage / darkness.

Note: The artwork should not be constrained to a particular period in time. Real world reference is preferred but students are allowed to push the fantastic.

The students must also include a 300-word explanation of the creative choices which led to the finished piece. Suggested styles include photography, computer-generated artwork, scratch-board, pointillism, chalk, charcoal, dry brush, watercolor, crosshatch, lead, collage, linoleum printing and crayon... but creativity is encouraged. Any type of 2D art will be accepted, so long as it meets the size requirements.

A panel of Parsons faculty and staff will select the top five student entries and submit those to Lucasfilm for consideration. **Deadline for submission: Wednesday, May 4th.** Here's how it works:

3. Each selected student must complete the Student Entry Packet including:
 - a. [Submission Form](#) (with Artist Statement) – see attached form.

- c. One version of their original 2D artwork

The finalists' artwork will be sent to Industrial Light and Magic and reviewed by a panel of selected judges for theme relevance, technical merit, composition and overall creativity.

OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

OVERVIEW

Lucasfilm Ltd. ("Lucasfilm" and "Sponsor") is proud to offer the Lucasfilm Student Art Competition ("Competition"). The Competition seeks to identify and reward exceptional art students.

1. **ELIGIBILITY.** The Competition is open to current students ("Students") matriculated into any of the following art programs on or before January 1, 2011: Art Center, California Institute of the Arts, Rhode Island School of Design, Ringling College, Savannah College of Art & Design - Atlanta, Savannah College of Art & Design – Savannah, School of Visual Arts, Texas A&M, University of Southern California, Parsons, and NYU (Tisch) (each an "Eligible Institution").

HOW TO ENTER.

- a. **Eligible School Registration.** Each Eligible Institution shall select from its student body up to five (5) Students to represent the Institution in the Competition. Once Students have been selected and have completed the Student Entry Packet, as outlined below and delivered it to the Eligible Institution contact, all Student Entry Packets shall be forwarded, along with the Institution Entry Form ("Full Entry"), to Sponsor, by mail, at the address listed on the Institution Entry Form. Entry must be postmarked no later than May 10, 2011 and received no later than eight (8) days later. Only completed Full Entries will be accepted. In the event one or more Student Entry Packets is incomplete, but the Institution Entry Form is complete, remaining Student Entries shall be considered.

7. **GENERAL CONDITIONS.** Each Competition Winner will be required to complete and return an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release and a W-9 Form (Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification Form) within seven (7) days of receipt before the Prize can be officially awarded. In compliance with US Internal Revenue Service regulations, Lucasfilm will issue a Form 1099-Misc to the Winner. The Winner remains solely responsible for paying all federal and other taxes in accordance with the laws that apply in the Winner's state of residence. Should a winner be deemed ineligible or fail to return the required forms within the time period allowed, an alternate winner may or may not be selected. Lucasfilm reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend or terminate the Competition should the administration or security of the Competition become compromised. Lucasfilm is not responsible for late, lost, incomplete, or misdirected Submissions. By entering, entrant, or in the case of a minor, the minor's parent or legal guardian, (a) agrees to be bound by the official rules and the decisions of Lucasfilm and the Eligible Institutions (including but not limited to eligibility determinations) which are final and binding in all respects; (b) agrees to release Lucasfilm, the Eligible Institutions and its employees and agents from any and all liability, loss, damage or injury resulting from participation in this Competition or awarding, receipt, possession use and/or misuse of any prize awarded herein and acknowledge that Lucasfilm the Eligible Institution, and any employees and agents have neither made nor are in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize; and (c) consent(s) to use of Eligible Entrant's name, Submission and/or likeness for advertising and promotional purposes in connection with this Competition without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law. Lucasfilm shall retain the right to cancel the Competition in the event it receives fewer than twenty (20) Entries.
8. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Competition is governed by the laws of the United States and the State of California, without respect to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in this Competition, all entrants agree that any and all disputes which cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with this Competition, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in the Northern District of California, having jurisdiction. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will participants be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g., costs associated with entering), and participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
9. **PRIVACY.** All personal information collected by Sponsor will be used for administration of the Competition, and as outlined in these Competition Guidelines. In addition, entrants may receive email correspondence from, or on behalf of Sponsor subject to Sponsor's privacy policy. Sponsor uses reasonable commercial efforts to comply with Federal CAN-SPAM guidelines, and entrants may subsequently opt-out of receiving further emails by following the opt-out instructions contained in the
